## Jazz Aspen Snowmass Local Education Initiative



**JAS-In-Schools** provides middle and high school students with an in-depth introduction to jazz from professional jazz musicians and educators.

**JAS-In-Schools Summer Camps** consist of three two-week sessions taught by members of *JASIS Faculty Band*. Each camp includes performance opportunities, and college students from CU, DU & UNC teach the first session, providing mentorship and instruction to advanced HS & MS students.

**LEI Faculty Assistance Program** is designed to provide local band directors with classroom assistance. There are currently five instructors on the LEI Faculty roster.

**Pays to Play** provides Roaring Fork Valley youth to take private lessons in any instrumental discipline. JAS will pay for the first three lessons to support & promote furthering music education, simultaneously supporting local music instructors.

**Stuff for Students** supports schools through instrument and equipment donations.

**The JAS Room** provides a variety of materials for teachers & students including jazz & jazz inspired play charts, sheet music, CD play-a-longs, method books, CD's, DVD's, biographies, jazz dictionaries, theory books, & a digital music collection featuring jazz standards. Located in Roaring Fork High School, this facility is available to teachers and students throughout the Roaring Fork Valley and I-70 corridor.

**Tickets for Teachers** JAS donates hundreds of tickets annually for its June & Labor Day festivals and other JAS performances to teachers and students within the Roaring Fork Valley.

## JAS Summer Camp Schedule

### June 9-22

The first session is jazz oriented and designed for intermediate to advanced middle and high school students. College students from the Denver area who are currently music majors will join the group for the last two days of the camp. Students will perform live at the Cooper Street Free Stage during the Jazz Aspen Snowmass June Festival.

### July 14-27

The second session is open to students who have had at least one year of band or those who have studied privately and acquired basic skills. The material is selected by the class and they will be learning to write their own charts. Students will perform live at the Carbon-dale Mountain Fair Festival.

### August 11-15

The final session is geared toward beginners, and focuses on learning the basics. The material is selected by the group along with some input from Chris Bank. All students will have the opportunity to program drum patterns as well as play drums to better understand the fundamentals of time, and will also have time to explore other instruments. Students will participate in a special performance for family and friends at Roaring Fork High School.

Each JAS Summer Camp takes place Monday—Friday from 10am-3pm at the Roaring Fork High School in Carbondale.
